

That it is agreed by and between the parties that the party of the first part will have its own transportation system for bringing the students to the hospital for taking education and taking them back; at any rate the party of the second part will not take any responsibility for transportation of the students of the party of the first part:

It is also agreed by the party of the first part that in case of any damage is occurred to the property of the party of the second part from the students while taking education, then it will be fully recouped or compensated by the party of the first part. In this regard the decision regarding the quantum of tamages decided by the party of the second part will be final and conclusive. The party of the first part will not raise any dispute about the said quantum of damages.

- Orthopedic, ICU, CCU, Dermatology wards, Pediatric (Medical, Surgical and intensive care) and OPDs.


