#### THEME - 'CHAMPIONING THE FIGHT TO STOP PNEUMONIA.'

World Pneumonia Day is dedicated to raising awareness about the disease named Pneumonia. It is observed every year on November 12. Pneumonia is a lung-based infection caused by bacteria, viruses, and fungi. The day marks an early diagnosis of the disease to seek the necessary steps to prevent the disease. Global events are organised to educate people about the causes and prevention of pneumonia.

#### WORLD PNEUMONIA DAY 2022: HISTORY AND SIGNIFICANCE

The day first came into effect on November 12, 2009, under the initiative named 'Stop Pneumonia'. This was a global coalition against child pneumonia. Later, WHO and UNICEF introduced an integrated plan to prevent and control the disease globally. Covid-19 is another factor that caused severe damage to the lungs. The reason behind observing this day is to aim for zero deaths caused by pneumonia by 2030.

## WORLD PNEUMONIA DAY 2022: SYMPTOMS AND TREATMENT

The symptoms of pneumonia range from mild to severe. That includes fever, cough, which may be dry, or produce a thick yellow, green, brown, or blood-stained mucus, difficulty in breathing, shivering, loss of appetite, lethargy, blood in the sputum, and chest pain.

The prevention of this disease is through maintaining hygiene, covering the mouth and nose with a mask, frequent washing of hands, and vaccines related to the flu.

Children living in areas with declining vaccination rates, rising malnutrition due to food shortages, and in homes that use polluting fuels for cooking and heating, are particularly vulnerable. UNICEF has predicted an explosion in child deaths if urgent action is not taken to reach these children, including with oxygen and antibiotics.

Older adults exposed to air pollution – most significantly from burning fossil fuels – and smoking are also at risk. Almost half of the estimated 1.6 million pneumonia deaths among adults aged over 50 are attributable to air pollution and smoking.

This World Pneumonia Day, on 12 November 2022, the Mérieux Foundation and Every Breath Counts have awarded 11 civil society organizations small grants to support events that strengthen local engagement in the fight against pneumonia.

The session of day celebration was very interactive along with discussion regarding the topic and resolution of their related queries,

The students have presented the posters based on the theme.

At the end of the session, the effectiveness of the seminar was assessed through the question answers and evaluation of the posters.

Under the guidance of Dr. Madhuri Shelke (Principal, INER, Pune) and Subject Incharge Ms. Madhuri Kotkar conducted the skill station on Assessment of preterm Baby

At the beginning of the skill station, knowledge was assessed by asking various questions, then preterm assessment was explained. The goal of program was to improve the knowledge of the students related health assessment of preterm baby and identify need of baby and mother. The purpose of Assessment of preterm Baby are to know the congenital anomalies, reduce morbidity and mortality rate and to identify any risk factor in preterm. For the assessment first step is to collect history of mother during antenatal, labour and postnatal period, family history and any genetic disorders. After history collection APGAR score will be assess that score must be in between 7-10 which to determine respiratory distress. Physical assessment must be start head to foot examination with length and weight and the anthropometry measurement and the last step is to check reflexes of preterm baby tonic reflex, moro reflex, rooting etc. like reflexes has to assess which indicate preterm baby normality and abnormality. After the assessment can identify what are the need of baby and mother like need of baby are Adequate breast

feeding - Protection from heat strokes - Prevention of infection in the ward - Maintenance of personal hygiene - Immunization - Growth monitoring, and need of mother are Adequate Nutrition - Postnatal exercises - Calcium Supplement - Family Planning -

After the session, again questions were asked to the students to assess the effectiveness of Skill station.

Students of 4<sup>th</sup> year B. B. Sc. Nursing students participated through presenting posters. The posters depicted various aspects such as-


- Theme of World Pancreatic Cancer Day: "It's About Time".





The session was ended with vote of thanks by Ms. Ashwini Palwade.


