- Immediate consequences of self-harm behaviour (relief from stress, relaxation, calmness, sleep, etc.), later consequences of self-harm behaviour (guilt, shame, stigma, feelings of isolation and abandonment).
- Aetiology of self-harm behaviour: serotonin, endorphin model.
- Risk factors: depression, trauma, eating disorders, conduct disorder, personality disorder.
- Self-harm interventions: thought stopping technique, positive stress management, identification of feelings and talking them out, learning social skills, etc.

Raising awareness about self-harm is incredibly important. Awareness leads to understanding and empathy, banishing judgment and fear, and reducing the number of people who feel alone and suffer in silence.
