According to research published in the Indian Journal of Medical and Paediatric Oncology, In India, cervical cancer contributes to approximately 6–29% of all cancers in women. Cervical cancer is a type of cancer that occurs in the cervix, the lower part of the uterus that connects to the vagina. It is primarily caused by persistent infection with high-risk strains of the human papillomavirus (HPV). In India, cervical cancer is the second most common cancer among women, largely due to a lack of awareness, delayed screenings, and limited access to healthcare. However, it is one of the most preventable cancers with proper vaccination, regular screening, and lifestyle modifications. Early detection can significantly reduce the risk of severe outcomes. In this article, we discuss how women in India can reduce their risk of cervical cancer.

- 7. Avoid long-term use of oral contraceptives without medical supervision
- 8. Ensure partner is vaccinated or tested
- 9. Avoid douching or harsh products
- 10. Raise awareness and educate others

4th Semester BscNursing students conducted seminar regarding the importance of donating Blood which can save otherslives. MissAshleshaManchekar explained the following topics.


