This year's theme emphasizes the importance of making handwashing accessible to everyone, regardless of their circumstances.

The stated aims of Global Handwashing Day are to: Foster and support a general culture of hand washing with soap in all societies. Shine a spotlight on the state of hand washing in each country. Raise awareness about the benefits of hand washing with soap. Key Times to Wash Hands. Before, during, and after preparing food. Before and after eating food. Before and after caring for someone at home who is sick with vomiting or diarrhoea. Before and after treating a cut or wound. After using the toilet. After changing diapers or cleaning up a child who has used the toilet. The students gave the health education in the OPD in a musical dance form. Students enacted the following seven steps of Hand washing as follows:-

- 1. Wet your hands with water.
- 2. Apply enough soap to cover your hands.
- 3. Rub your hands together.
- 4. Use I hand to rub the back of the other hand and clean in between the fingers. ...
- 5. Rub your hands together and clean in between your fingers.
- 6. Rub the back of your fingers against your palms.
- 7. Rub your thumb using your other hand.





The creativity of the students displayed colorfulness and use of cost-effective material in the form of Model preparation was highly appreciated. Students appreciated the innovative method of learning.


