Station 2 performed the steps of procedure as per the check list.


Station 3 students documented the procedure in file and maintained nurse's notes.

Station 5 student had attended the Viva of observer.


During skills Station students actively participated. Session was beneficiary for students and cleared the doubt regarding new born assessment and OSCE.

The skill station ended with vote of Thanks.




