With keeping this in mind, students of 4th year B.Sc Nursing has conducted health education program.

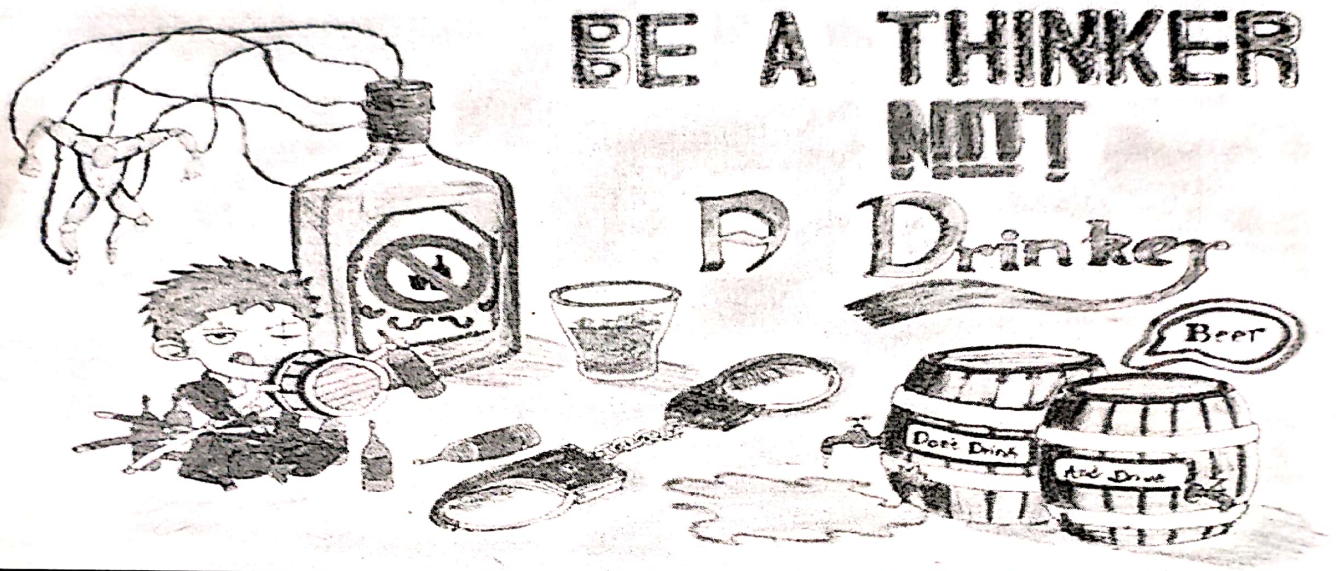

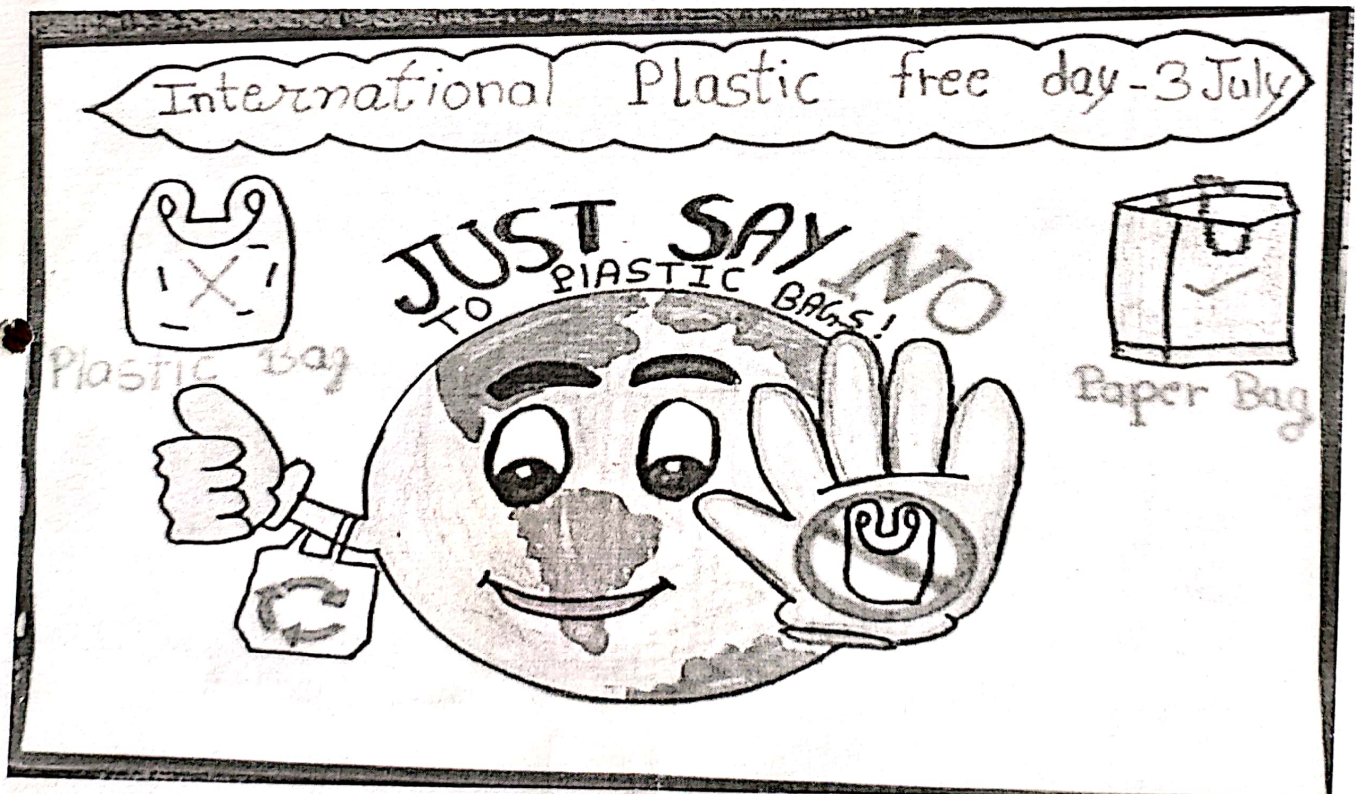
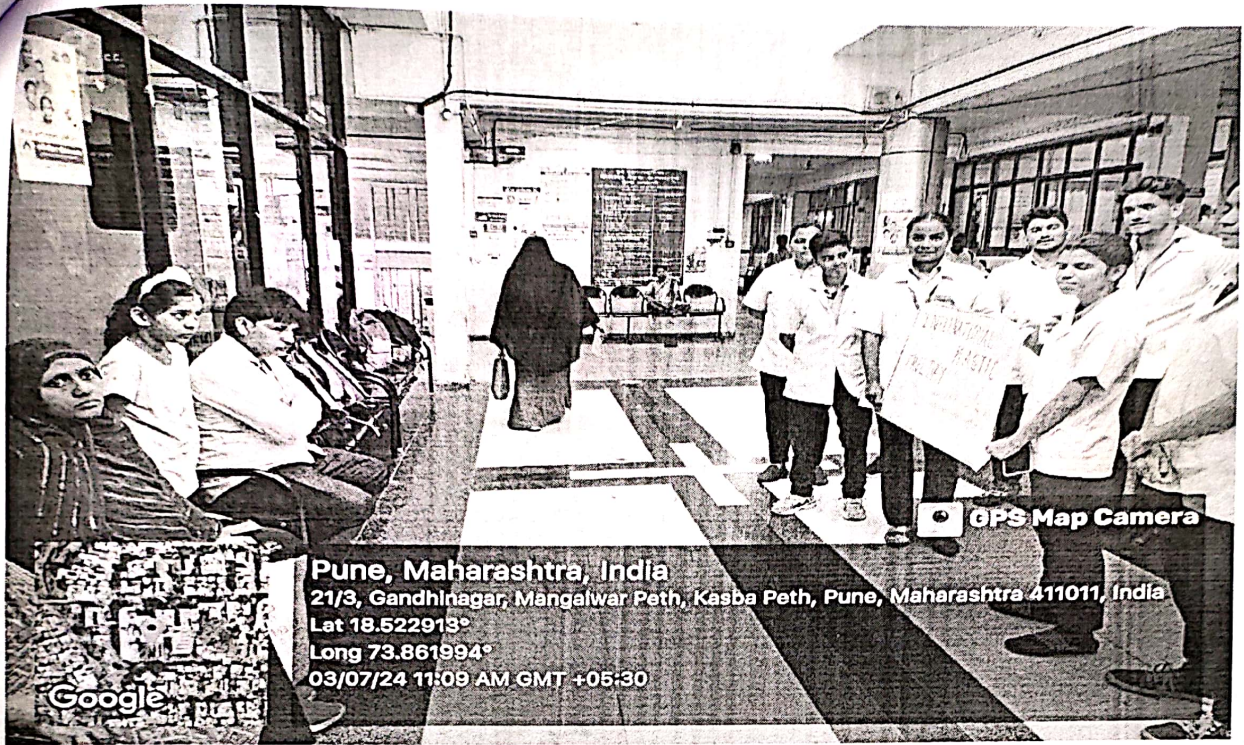
Significance

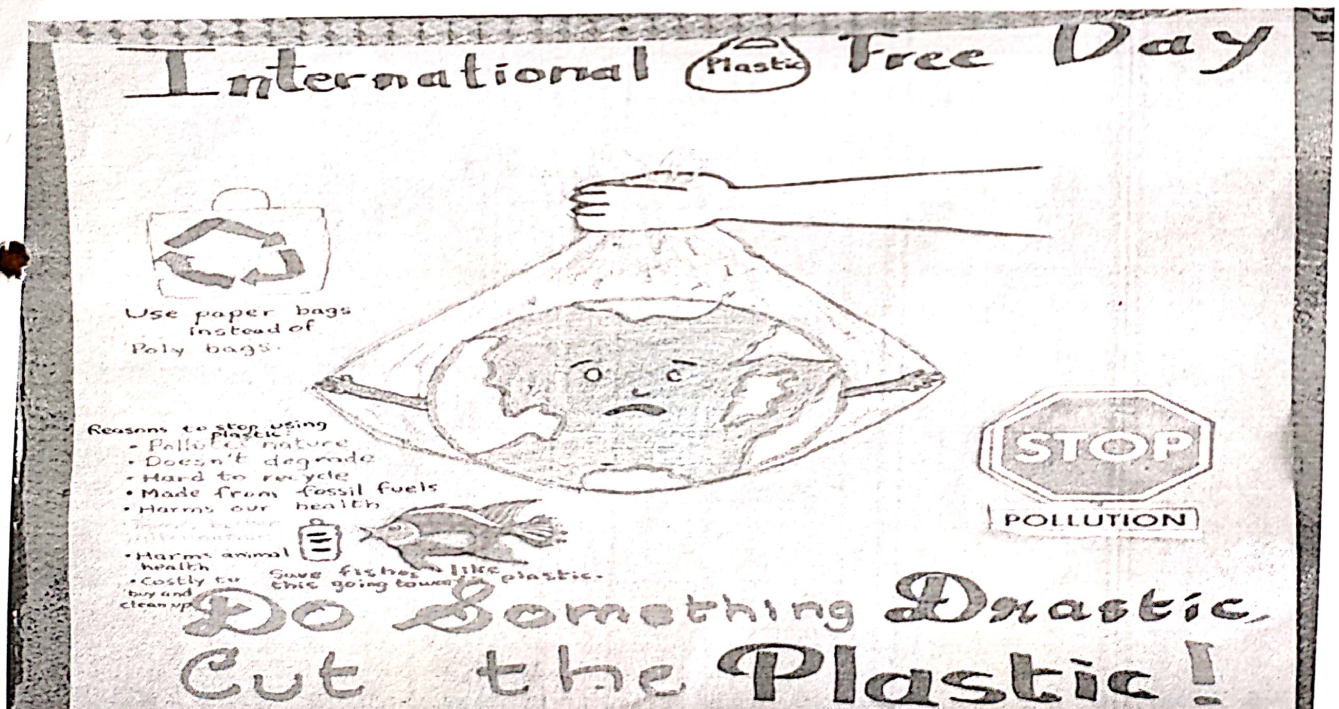
